2015 MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC



Region – New Zealand is known for its world class Sauvignon Blanc and there is no doubt Marlborough is the epicentre of the variety. Grapes for this wine come from the subregion of the Awatere Valley (which means fast flowing stream in Maori) where the closer proximity to the coast means cooler weather which allows for longer growing season providing unique characters in the wine.

Style – This juicy Sauvignon Blanc showcases lashings of passionfruit and Citrus with impressive length on the palate capturing the essence of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.

Colour – Pale Straw

Bouquet - Upfront notes of passionfruit and sherberty citrus.

Palate - Passionfruit follows on from the nose complexed by subtle hints of juicy tropical fruit. A zippy and refreshing citrus finish comes courtesy of lively, flinty acids.

Food Match – A versatile variety that can be enjoyed on its own but fantastic paired with seafood and salads, as well as Greek, Mexican and Thai food.
